Comes now, Marjorie M. Zemkewicz, as Personal Representative of the estate of Robert P. Bolin, deceased, and being duly sworn upon her oath, respectfully shows the Court as follows:

- 1. That on or about August 20, 2010, David Bolin, by counsel, filed with this Court Objection to Petition for Allowance of Fees to Personal Representative and Attorney.
- 2. That Personal Representative objects to all objections to fees raised in David
 Bolin's Objection to Petition for Allowance of Fees to Personal Representative and Attorney.
- David Bolin's request for a copy of the engagement letter involving the employment of Krieg

 DeVault LLP is protected under I.C. 34-46-3-1(1) as attorney-client privileged communication.
- 4. The main asset of the decedent, residence located at 14515 Lake Shore Drive, Cedar Lake, Lake County, Indiana was appraised at \$85,000.00 which is verified by the appraisal, a copy of which is attached hereto, made a part hereof and labeled Exhibit "A."
- 5. David Bolin, when he indicated his desire to purchase decedent's residence in April of 2009, made an offer to purchase for \$90,000.00 but refused to make an earnest money deposit in connection with his offer. His \$90,000.00 offer was rejected by the Personal Representative who presented a counter-offer of \$100,000.00.

- 6. David Bolin hired attorney James Nagy in May, 2009 and negotiations continued with Mr. Nagy for Mr. Bolin's purchase of decedent's residence with Mr. Nagy until Mr. Bolin hired attorney Shaun T. Olsen in July, 2009.
- 7. In July, 2009, David Bolin made another offer to purchase decedent's residence; however, this offer was in the amount of \$85,000.00, less than his original offer of \$90,000.00 made in May, 2009 and less than the Personal Representative's counter-offer of \$100,000.00. The handling of these various offers and communications with the heir and his several attorneys were extraordinary services provided to this estate by the estate's attorney and Personal Representative.
- 8. On July 21, 2009, David Bolin, by counsel, Shaun T. Olsen, filed Petition to Convert to Supervised Administration and requested hearing for determination of bond. Said hearing was set by the Court for September 22, 2009. The time incurred to open the estate as unsupervised was wasted and the follow-up to the conversion were extraordinary services provided to this estate by the estate's attorney and Personal Representative.
- 9. After David Bolin advised he was not able to purchase decedent's residence, the Personal Representative accepted an offer to purchase for \$100,000.00 in September, 2009. Since there was no realtor involved, the estate's attorney and Personal Representative worked closely with the buyer and the buyer's agents, including the buyer's bank, to close the transaction. The time and expense incurred to manage the transaction without a realtor were extraordinary services provided to this estate by the estate's attorney and Personal Representative.
- 10. As a supervised estate, Personal Representative was required to file a petition for authority to sell real estate and obtain approval of Executrix's Deed. As required, the Personal

Representative filed a Petition for Authority to Sell Real Estate and David Bolin filed an objection to the sale.

- 11. After hearing upon Personal Representative's Petition for Authority to Sell Real Estate and David Bolin's objections, the Court granted the petition in October, 2009. Attending the contested hearing to sell the real estate for a profit of \$15,000.00 without any deduction for realtor fees, over the objection of David Bolin, were extraordinary services provided to this estate by the estate's attorney and Personal Representative.
- 12. Personal Representative sold decedent's residence for \$100,000.00, for a \$15,000.00 profit and did so without incurring commissions for a realtor.

- 13. Some of the decedent's personal property, including the decedent's television was stolen from this estate. The theft was reported to local authorities, the Personal Representative investigated the theft with the neighbors and appropriate documents were filed with the Court to report the theft. The services provided to this estate by the estate's attorney and Personal Representative were extraordinary services.
- The Personal Representative has been advised by counsel that it is the normal and customary procedure under Rule 5.3 of the Indiana Rules of Court to utilize the services of a paralegal, legal assistant, or a non-lawyer, for supervised assistance provided by an attorney at law.
- 15. Although David Bolin, through his petition, characterizes the preparation of documents to open and administer an estate as ministerial work, the Personal Representative believes that it is important that the documentation prepared be accurate and the Personal Representative be provided with legal assistance on the procedures to be followed in order to carry out her duties as required by law.

16. The estate's attorney and Personal Representative provided both usual and customary services to administer this estate and many special and extraordinary services to administer this estate.

WHEREFORE, Marjorie M. Zemkewicz, as Personal Representative of the estate of Robert P. Bolin, respectfully requests that the Personal Representative's Petition for Allowance of Fees to Personal Representative and Attorney, as submitted to this Court, be approved in its entirety.

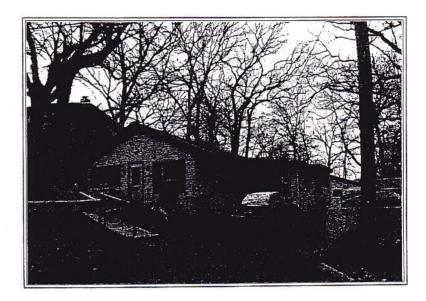

Condition of Improvements

The subject improvements were found to be in below average condition at the time of the inspection with items of deferred maintenance observed.

At the time of the inspection, the subject kitchen floor was sloping to the north and to the south. The client informed the appraiser that the estimated cost to correct the sloping floors was \$2,500.00. This figure has been factored into the condition adjustments applied in the Market Approach to Value.

The appraiser is not a home inspector and this appraisal report is not part of a home inspection. The appraiser only performed a typical visual appraisal inspection. A professional home inspection is suggested.

The subject property appears to have a room addition which was added at some point in time after the property was originally built in 1914. The addition appears to include the 2 rear bedrooms and the den. This type of improvement is not uncommon for the area and does not have a negative impact on value or marketability.

Adverse Environmental Conditions

No environmental hazards were apparent or suspect at the time of the inspection and the value estimated in this report is based on the assumption that the property is not negatively affected by the existence of hazardous substances or detrimental environmental conditions. However, since the appraiser is not an expert in this field, it is possible that the test and inspections made by a qualified hazardous materials and environmental expert would reveal the existence of hazardous materials and environmental conditions on or around the property that would negatively affect its value.

Comments on Sales Comparison

The subject property is located in a very stable market area of Cedar Lake, Indiana. Sales of residences which are similar to the subject property in terms of square footage, room count, and architectural style have been limited in the preceding twelve months. Therefore, after consulting with the N.W. Indiana MLS service and area brokers, the appraiser found it necessary to utilize sales which varied from the subject.

In addition, it was necessary to include sales from outside the desired one mile radius. No location adjustment to reconcile proximity was necessary as all properties are located in the same general market with similar appeal, housing prices, and housing stock.

Finally, the appraiser has included sales which are smaller than the subject. All three of the comparable sales have lake rights similar to the subject. Location and lake rights have a significant impact on value and the appraiser has chosen comparables sales with these similar features. No additional sales with 900 to 1,500 square feet of gross living area (with similar lake rites/influences) were noted.

Although the sales used vary in the aforementioned areas, they are believed to provide a reliable indication of market value as of the date of inspection. Adjustments were necessary and are outlined as follows: Lot size adjustments are based upon the contributory value the excess land has on the overall value of the property. A condition adjustment was applied to sales #land #3 and are based upon the MLS listing for each sale. Room count and amenity adjustments are based upon the most probable market reaction to these differences in terms of price. Gross living area adjustments are applied at \$15.00 per square foot of above grade gross living area.

After all pertinent adjustments, the three closed sales reflect an adjusted value range of \$84,099 to \$98,100. The subject identifies most closely with the lower end of this range in terms of location, design, condition, and room count similarities, indicating an estimated value of \$85,000.
